

Combat Airsoft Player Agreement

The organisers cannot take responsibility for any injury or loss/damage to personal property whilst on the site. All participants must read and sign the following certificate before commencement of play to show they fully understand and will abide by the site rules.

SITE RULES please read carefully:

- Airsoft is an adrenaline filled action based game where participants shoot airsoft guns at one another, there is a risk of receiving minor injuries such as cuts and bruising from this and a greater risk from falls or trips associated with playing such games in woodland.
- You must wear suitable footwear with ankle support. No trainers are allowed.
- All safety instructions given by directing staff must be followed at all times.
- All players must attend the safety briefing at the start of each days play.
- Move around the site in a responsible manner, the ground may be uneven and slippery so exercise caution when moving.
- We recommend wearing a full face mask for the event but at your own risk at the very least protective glasses must be worn in the gaming area. They must remain in position, even between games until you are back in the safe zone. Under 16's Must wear full face protection.
- Headshots must be avoided if possible especially at close range.
- Site fps limit is 328fps with a +/- to max 350 fps. Single shot sniper weapons 500fps with a 20meter minimum engagement distance. Snipers must be certified by site. Both measured with a 0.2gBB. You are agreeing to be shot at by airsoft weapons at these velocities.
- Whilst in the safe zone no weapon is to be loaded or have a magazine attached, magazines must be removed and the chamber cleared before entering the safe zone.
- No firing down paths between gaming areas.
- Single shot only in buildings. This rule may be uplifted at the discretion of Combat Airsoft staff.
- Only pyrotechnic devices agreed by the directing staff may be used. These include smoke grenades and low noise distraction devices.
- No blades or knives other than tools for gun repairs are allowed on site, No blades except LARP safe items may be taken into the game zones.
- Should a member of the public stray on to the gaming area play you must immediately shout "Cease Fire" place your weapon at your feet and call for a Marshall. The Marshall will then deal with the issue. Players are not under any circumstances to confront the straying member of the public.
- We operate a 'no blind firing' policy. This means you must have a clear line of sight on your target while looking down the sights of your weapon before opening fire.
- The consuming of alcohol or any non-prescription drugs is forbidden on site. Any players found to violate this rule will be immediately expelled from the site and banned. If required the necessary authorities may be called.
- Smoking is only allowed in the 'dead zone' areas. Areas of the safe zone under cover are strictly no smoking.
- All litter is to be placed in the bins provided by directing staff.

Were rental equipment is issued it will be issued in an undamaged and working condition. You agree to return all equipment in working and undamaged condition. Should any damage occur through player fault as deemed by the site manager you agree to pay towards the repair costs.

I agree for my details to be kept on computer by Combat Airsoft under the data protection act, Combat Airsoft will not disclose your details to any other body or individual and only use them for information on airsoft games and for contact details. At your request or at the end of the document period your details will be removed.
